
Dear Community Partner

Alabama State University and the Legacy Museum Tour - July 21, 2023

Covered Ministries coordinated a 1 day tour of both Alabama State University and the Legacy Museum. 15 teens along with parents and mentors experienced the Legacy Museum and absorbed the cultural impact of a historically black university.





Morehouse College & Spelman College Campus Tours - July 22, 2022

Covered Ministries coordinated campus visits to both Morehouse and Spelman in downtown Atlanta. Ten teens along with parents and mentors learned about the history and cultural impact of the historically black colleges.



Community Partner Volunteerism

We developed partnerships with several Gwinnett area nonprofits to offer volunteer support and community service learning for teens. We have been able to leverage these partnerships to assist single parent households with fresh produce and non-perishable food. Opportunities to serve the community are on Saturdays and weekdays (during the summer months).













Social Events and Other Activities

During the summer mentoring program, our students can participate in a number of special activities including basketball camp and community outreach events, tennis clinic, youth heartscan workshops, blessing ceremonies, family bowling, baseball games and escape rooms.
